Special notes:

- Exhibitors may make any number of entries in each section but must enter each item online individually.
- All items entered will become the property of the Western Fair Association. *Entries <u>will not</u> be returned* to the exhibitor but will be distributed to the organizations listed below.

#### Class & Description

- DOLL/STUFFED TOY: Create a doll or stuffed toy. Must not have any sharp objects or things that will make these items unsafe for a child. Please keep in mind there are many different cultures who are helped by these organizations so multicultural items are appreciated.
  - ✓ These items will be donated to Life\*Spin or Merrymount.
- 2. **RED SCARVES:** Knit or crochet a scarf (minimum size of 6" x 60"). Plain red scarves to support the Red Scarf initiative.
  - ✓ All scarves will be donated to **Regional HIV/AIDS Connection**.
- **3. SOCKS:** Knit or crochet a pair of socks.
  - ✓ All pairs of socks will be donated to 519 pursuit in support of their annual 519 pledge.
  - **4. TEEN QUILT:** Sized 53" x 74" for a teenager. Non-religious and youth friendly fabric and designs. Created using any quilting method.
    - All quilts entered into this category will be donated to Ronald McDonald House Charities
      Southwestern Ontario (RMHC-SWO) where they will be distributed to families with teenagers who are in the hospital.

### Straw Bale Decorating (Division 51)

Entry Fee: \$5.00 + (\$45 deposit\*) = \$50.00 \*\$45 deposit is returned to you after completing your Straw Bale decorating on Wednesday, August 16<sup>th</sup>. Prize Money: **1st-** \$250, **2nd-** \$100, **3rd-** \$50

NOTE: This division is open to *organizations only*.

*Example:* Service/sports clubs, senior centres, churches, guilds, classrooms, businesses, etc.

Decorate a straw bale to represent your organization! Spray paint, glue and add decorations so you can't tell it used to be a boring straw bale! Get those creative juices flowing!

Special notes:

- There are a limited number of spots available for this competition.
- Western Fair will provide the straw bale. Size: approx. 5-foot diameter.
- You must bring all materials to decorate your bale to Western Fair (paint, décor items, etc).
- Bales will be judged on all decorations, plus, creativity in how it relates to your organization.
- Western Fair will make one sign 8.5" x 11" stating your organizations name which will be placed on or near your design.
- Must be a family friendly design.
- The bale must stay upright as you found it.
- Everything must be attached to the straw bale. No items on the ground.
- You have approximately 2 hours to decorate.
- Must be able to decorate on August 16<sup>th</sup>. Latest start time available is 5:30pm.
