A Few Things to Remember

- Read General Rules and Information on pages 2-5.
- Only one entry per class. Exhibitors can enter each class.
- Fill out the entry form completely and submit it online by closing date.
- All articles entered must be the property of the person/persons in whose name they are entered.
- Any entries not picked up by the pickup deadline will be disposed of.
- All items must have been created in the last 2 years (since 2022), and be the work of the exhibitor.
- Judges will be looking for uniqueness, creativity, and technique in all classes.
- The Western Fair may combine any Class or Classes where there are not sufficient entries to provide competition.
  - A competition requires 3 entries per class. If there are not sufficient entries only a ribbon may be awarded (no prize money)

## Youth Craft Competition – (Division 40)

#### NO ENTRY FEE.

Prize Money for each Class: **1st-** \$20, **2nd-** \$15, **3rd-** \$10 All youth prize winners are given cash upon entry being picked up on pick-up day

#### Class & Description

AGES 5 & Under

- 1. **PAPER BAG PIRATE:** Using a paper bag, create a pirate.
- 2. **PET ROCK:** Create a pet rock by painting and decorating a rock you found outside.
- 3. **ART:** Any medium on paper or canvas created at home or at school may be entered. Example: Painting, pastel, pen, pencil, crayon, or marker drawing.
- 4. **PAPER ROLL MONSTERS:** Create a monster using a toilet paper roll. Stick, draw, or paint assorted craft materials on the roll to make your monster. Must be able to stand upright.
  - 5. **POPSICLE STICK SNAKES:** Use markers, paint, and other decor to create a snake out of popsicle sticks.







#### <u>AGES 6 - 10</u>

- 6. **LEGO:** Build a unique sculpture using Lego or Duplo (no kits). *Include a label with a title and short description of your creation.* Must be able to be transported by Western Fair staff.
- 7. TISSUE PAPER COLLAGE BIRDHOUSE: Decorate a birdhouse using tissue paper, glue, and paint. Birdhouse can be a purchased or homemade with a milk carton, cardboard, or anything else you can think of! Please attach string to hang.
  - 8. **ART:** Any medium on paper or canvas created at home or at school may be entered. Ex. Painting, pastel drawing, pen, and ink drawing.
- 9. **PIPE CLEANER PENCIL TOPPERS:** Create <u>3 pencil toppers</u> out of colourful pipe cleaners and display them on the top of unsharpened pencils. Maximum 3 toppers. Examples include animals, bugs, favorite characters, etc.
  - 10. **FINGER KNITTING SNAKES:** Create a finger knitted snake. Video tutorial is available here: <u>https://www.redtedart.com/finger-knitting-snakes/</u>







#### <u>AGES 11 – 15</u>

- 1. **LEGO:** Build a unique sculpture using Lego or Duplo (no kits). *Include a label with a title and short description of your creation.* Must be able to be transported by Western Fair staff.
- 2. WACKY SHOES: Decorate a new or old pair of shoes to show off your personal style or theme!
- PAPIER-MÂCHÉ CACTUS: Create your own unique cactus with papier-mâché decorated with paint and other materials. Must be in a pot and able to stand on it's own.
  - 4. **STRING ART:** Using a piece of wood and nails, create a Fair themed string art design. Think cotton candy, ferris wheel, popcorn, a cow, etc. Max size: 8.5" x 11".
  - 5. **ART:** Any medium on paper or canvas created at home or at school may be entered. Ex. Painting, pastel drawing, pen and ink drawing.

**Class & Description** 

- 1. MARBLE DIPPED MUG: Decorate a personalized marbled mug out of nail polish and warm water. Find a tutorial (NEW) here: How To Make Nail Polish Marbled Mugs (youtube.com)
- NEW 2. PAPER FLOWER ARRANGEMENT: Create a flower arrangement out of paper suitable for any occasion. Displayed in a mason jar.
- NEW 3. HARVEST WREATH: Create a wreath for the upcoming autumn season out of craft materials. Ready to hang.
  - 4. UGLY LAMP: Add your own wacky touch to create an ugly lamp. Lamp must function for judging, may be plugged in during Fair.
  - 5. CARD MAKING: Make a card for any occasion (card only, no envelopes). Any design method EXCEPT digital (can be hand drawn, painted, embellished, etc.). Min size: 4" x 6". Must be able to stand for displaying.
  - 6. **PECULIAR PURSE:** Repurpose an old purse laying around the house into a work of art!
  - 7. JUNK CHIME: Use items found around your house to create a *musical* wind chime. Ideas can include spoons, forks and even your old pots and pans. Must be ready to hang.
  - 8. BUTTON ART: Make use of all those old buttons you've accumulated over the years, and turn them into art!
- NEW 9. ADULT LEGO: Create a sculpture using Lego. Must be able to be transported by Western Fair staff. No kits. No items permitted to be glued together.
